House Rules



- ★ Recreational Soccer Leagues are for the “Kids” and it should be fun and educational.
- ★ All Coaches must display coaching Badges.
No Badge = No Coach
- ★ All Coaches must wear their coach shirt during games.
No Shirt = No Coach
- ★ Good Sportsmanship should always be displayed, watch the goal differential, any differential of more than 4 goals should let coaches know to put your defense on offense and limit scores. **If you win big – everyone loses.**
- ★ During League Games, always play down to your opponent’s #'s.
- ★ Do not yell or shout at the referees, they to are learning and trying their hardest. If you have a referee issue remember referee calls are not challengeable. Bring any referee issues to a Board Member after the game.
- ★ Problems between coaches will be resolved after the game and off the field with a board member present.
- ★ Any parent helping a coach during practices or games must have a City of Hollywood Badge or have a background check application in process.
- ★ No unregistered/unrostered players are allowed to practice with your team or play in any games. Any games including unregistered players will result in a forfeit.
- ★ All players that show up for a game must play at least 50% of the game and goalies are only allowed to play ½ a game in goal. U14+ are the only division allowed to play a goalie for a full game.
- ★ **No parents or siblings of the coach or the players are allowed to sit on the team’s bench or their sidelines.**
- ★ When weather is bad, assume game will be played unless you have received a RainedOut alert text/e-mail (text the word **Boggs** to **84483** to sign up, it’s free)
- ★ When the “Lightning Alarm” sounds all participants must leave the field and not return until the all clear alarm of three short blasts is made.
- ★ A parent or designated parent should attend all practices, you are coaching, not babysitting. If parents are leaving the field they should notify you and provide contact phone #. If any parents are abusing this rule you should bring this to the board’s attention.

(U8 GHSL – U18 House Rules)

U8-U10* Play 7v7, size 4 ball, 2x25 minute halves, no heading, buildout line rule

U12* Play 9v9, size 4 ball, 2x30 minute halves, no heading

U14+ Play 11v11 if on big field – 9v9 smaller field (4v4 or 5v5 for teams that are short players on mini fields), size 5 ball, 2x35 minute halves

All FIFA game laws will be applied.

INJURED PLAYERS

When an injured player (exclusive of the goalkeeper) is attended to on the field of play, the player must leave the field of play for treatment and evaluation. A substitution may be made for the injured player. If the team plays short, the injured player will not be allowed back onto the field of play without the permission of the referee. The injured player may re-enter the field from any point on the boundary lines if the ball is out of play; if the ball is in play the player may re-enter only from the touch line. The trainer or coach shall not enter the field of play without the approval of the referee. (Note: If removing the player from the field will cause the number of player on the field to fall below the minimum required, the referee will allow a reasonable time for the injured player to be treated before allowing the match to continue.)

FYSA CODE OF ETHICS

Players

- I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials and parents at all times.
- I will remember that soccer is an opportunity to learn and have fun.
- I deserve to play in an environment that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol; and expect everyone to refrain from their use at all soccer games.
- I will do the best I can each day, remembering that all players have talents and weaknesses the same as I do.
- I will treat my coaches, other players and coaches, game officials, other administrators, and fans with respect at all times; regardless of race, sex, creed, or abilities, and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- I will concentrate on playing soccer. Always giving my best effort.
- I will play by the rules at all times.
- I will at all times control my temper, resisting the temptation of retaliate.
- I will always exercise self control.
- Conduct during competition towards play of the game and all officials shall be in accordance with appropriate behavior and in accordance with FIFA's "Laws of the Game", and in adherence to FYSA rules.
- While traveling, shall conduct themselves so as to being credit to themselves and their team.
- Alcohol, illegal drugs and unauthorized prescription drugs shall not be possessed, consumed or distributed before, during or after any game or at any other time at the field and/or game complex.

Coaches/Volunteers

- I will never place the value of winning before the safety and welfare of all players
- I will always show respect for players, other coaches, and game officials.
- I will lead by example, demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship at all times.
- I will be demonstrate knowledgeable of the rules of the game, and teach these rules to my players.
- I will never use abusive or insulting language. I will treat everyone with dignity.
- I will not tolerate inappropriate behavior, regardless of the situation.
- I will not allow the use of anabolic agents or stimulants, drugs, tobacco, or alcohol by any of my players.
- I will never knowingly jeopardize the eligibility and participation of a student-athlete.
- Youth have a greater need for example than criticism. I

- will be the primary soccer role model.
- I will at all times conduct myself in a positive manner.
- Coaching is motivating players to produce their best effort, inspiring players to learn, and encouraging players to be winners.
- Coach's actions on sidelines during games shall be in the spirit of "good sportsmanship" at all times. Profanity, profane gestures, arguing, inciting disruptive behavior by spectators and/or players, or any conduct not in the spirit of good sportsmanship, shall require disciplinary action from the affiliate.
- Alcohol, illegal drugs and unauthorized prescription drugs shall not be possessed, consumed or distributed before, during or after any game or at any other time at the field and/or game complex.
- I will refrain from any activity or conduct that may be detrimental or reflect adversely upon FYSA, its members or its programs
- I will accurately and completely complete the coach/volunteer application form and by application attest to the accuracy of the information submitted.

Parents/Spectators

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, game officials, and administrators. at all times.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of all players ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will support the coaches, officials, and administrators working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will remember that the game is for the players, not for the adults.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, game officials, administrators, and fans with respect.
- I will always be positive.
- I will always allow the coach to be the only coach.
- I will not get into arguments with the opposing team's parents, players, or coaches.
- I will not come onto the field for any reason during the game.
- I will not criticize game officials.
- Alcohol, illegal drugs and unauthorized prescription drugs shall not be possessed, consumed or distributed before, during or after any game or at any other time at the field and/or game complex.
- I will refrain from any activity or conduct that may be detrimental or reflect adversely upon FYSA, its members or its programs

Failure to comply may result in the suspension of your privilege to participate in FYSA sanctioned events, for the following periods: 1st offense suspension minimum thirty (30) days to a maximum of five (5) years, 2nd offense suspension for a minimum of one (1) year to a maximum of Ten (10) years, 3rd offense suspension for a minimum of five (5) years to a maximum of fifty (50) years.
